## HEALTH & SAFETY

Rain or shine, hot or cold...we march! Please check the weather report and please be sure to dress appropriately. We look forward to another peaceful and safe march this year! Since the inaugural march, WMSD has partnered with SD law enforcement and emergency response in order to address marcher safety.

We acknowledge that not all members of our community feel safe among law enforcement, and that is why WMSD has a team of marshals (wearing bright pink vests) who are trained in de-escalation.

## TRANSPORTATION & PARKING

- **COASTER:** The **COASTER** will be running this year, we'll post any updates with additional train information as we approach the 18th.
- **AMTRAK:** Link to timetable for **Amtrak Pacific Surfliner**.
- **SPRINTER:** Passengers on all **SPRINTER** trains must have the appropriate fare. One-way and round-trip tickets can be purchased at the station ticket vending machines, and day-passes can be purchased ahead of time via the NCTD mobile app, **Compass Cloud**.
- **MTS (Bus & Trolley):** **Schedules and Real Time updates**. MTS Rapid 235 runs high frequency bus service down the I-15 from the Escondido transit center to downtown with minimal stops. MTS will be running extra Trolley service the morning of the event. All three Trolley lines will have service at least every 15 minutes leading up to the event, with extra added service after the march. Marchers are encouraged to use free Park & Ride lots along the Trolley, and save time by getting transit tickets on their phones using the **Compass Cloud app**.
- **PARK & RIDE:** Park at **SDCCU Stadium (formerly Qualcomm)** and catch the trolley. MTS has 5,000 free parking spots. **Compass Cloud mobile ticketing app** is the fastest option to get Trolley passes in advance. Exit at the County Center/Little Italy Station.

- **PARK DOWNTOWN:** Search for and reserve parking in **downtown**
